Collegiate Responsibility (All Staff)

- To ensure all aspects of provision at Carnforth High School are outstanding and meet the needs
 of all learners
- To work to surmount all barriers to progress
- To deliver outstanding support of all learners
- To maintain high visibility and personal credibility at all times
- To set the culture by consistently upholding the vision, values and policies of the school
- To consistently challenge and support all learners to enable them to make progress
- To represent the school in the community and beyond
- To take on duties in a rota system as if required

Specific to this Role

Main Purpose

- Ensure learners survive, thrive and progress.
- Monitor and intervene to support learners at risk of underachievement.
- Ensure effective communication and liaison to support learners.
- Be aware and mindful of pupils' specific and individual needs.

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Day-to-day Role

- Support pupils with their academic work.
- Liaise with teaching staff to ensure the work provided is appropriate and provides challenge.
- Deliver tutoring to small groups of 3-4 pupils (Years 7-11).
- Prepare and adapt tutoring materials where necessary.
- Listen to learners and help them resolve any issues that are creating barriers to learning/participation in lessons.
- Complete admin roles within The Wave as directed by the provision manager
- To record attendance in The Wave.
- To follow individual pupil's support plans to ensure needs are being met/ reasonable adjustments being made.
- Inspire and motivate learners.
- Fulfil lunchtime, breaktime and morning duties in the Wave.
- Maintain accurate records and contribute to reports where necessary.
- Adapt to the day-to-day needs of pupils within The Wave.

Person Specification

- Qualified teacher status **or** graduate/ degree equivalent. Must have GCSE English and Maths at Grade 4/ Grade C or above.
- Ability to relate well to children and adults and an understanding of learning and development.
- Interested in teaching/ mentoring small groups of pupils.
- Knowledge of educational practices/ methods.
- Ability to organise and supervise the work of pupils to ensure they make good progress.
- Ability to communicate with a range of pupils and adults.
- Ability to establish and maintain good relationships with a range of pupils and adults.
- Desire to support vulnerable pupils in the academic setting (including those with SEN, EBSA, neurodivergence and poor mental health.
- Capacity to motivate, inspire and challenge pupils, self and others.
- Conscientious, reliable and empathetic.
- Good listening skills.
- Flexible and adaptable.
- Ability to work on own initiative.
- An understanding of and commitment to equal opportunities issues both within the workplace and the community in general.
